

# HOW TO FERTILIZE CITRUS TREES

WITH

## "ARIZONA'S BEST" CITRUS FOOD

"FORMULATED FOR ARIZONA SOILS"

### WHEN TO APPLY:

APPLY 3 TIMES A YEAR

1. FEBRUARY, MARCH
2. MAY, JUNE
3. AUGUST, SEPTEMBER

### HOW TO APPLY:

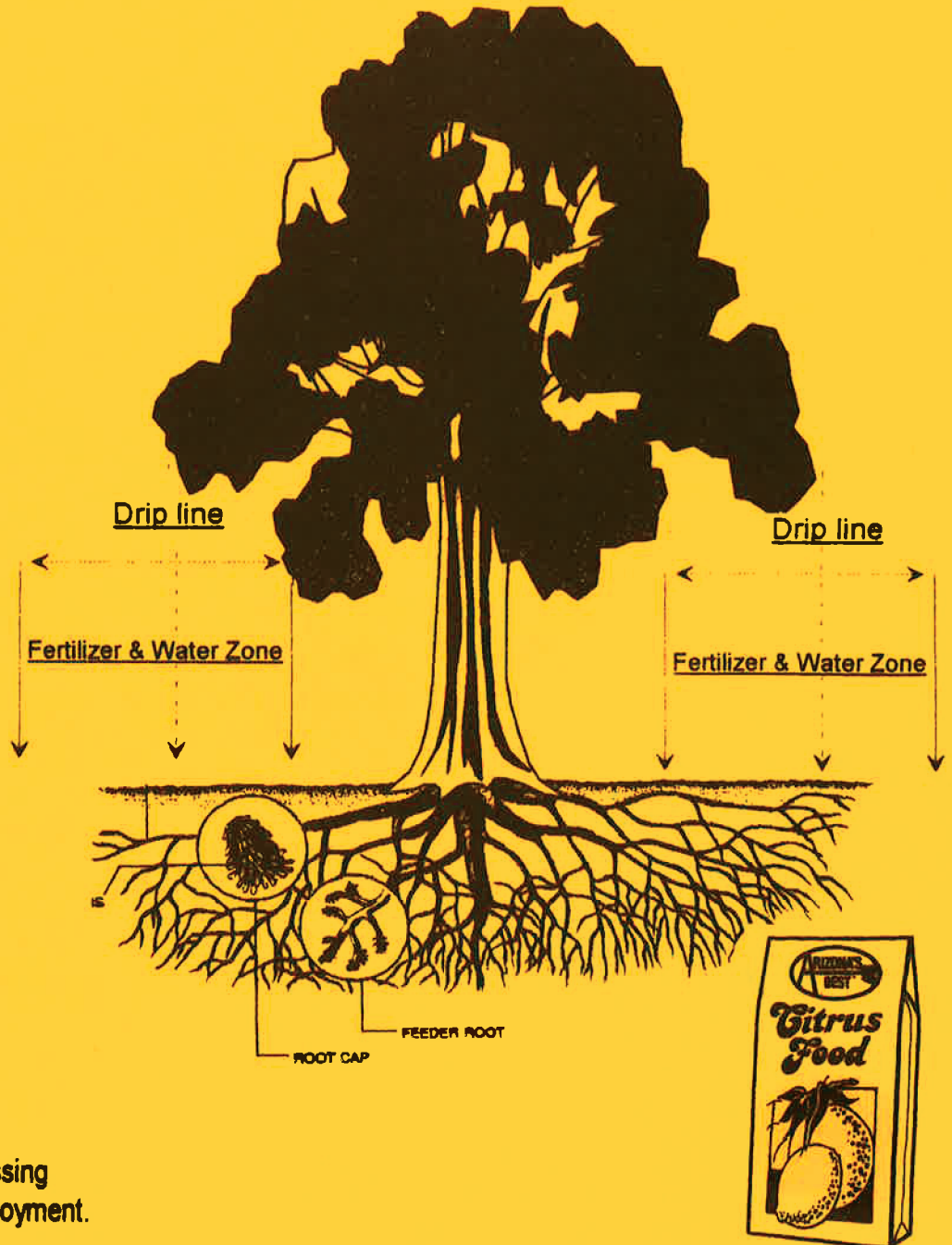
1. SPREAD "ARIZONA'S BEST" CITRUS FOOD EVENLY AROUND TREE IN THE FERTILIZER & WATER ZONE.
2. DEEP WATER AFTER EACH TIME FERTILIZER IS APPLIED.

### HOW MUCH FERTILIZER TO APPLY PER FEEDING:

- NEWLY PLANTED = 1 TBSP.  
TREES 2' to 4' = 1/4 CUP  
TREES 4' to 6' = 1 CUP  
MATURE TREE: 5# to 10#

### DID YOU KNOW:

1. Most citrus roots are within the top two feet of soil.
2. Citrus feeder roots extend well beyond the Drip Line.
3. Young trees should be watered more often, but not as deep as mature trees. Ask your nursery Pro for watering instructions on newly planted trees.
4. Deep Water mature trees about every 7-10 days in the summer and once a month in the winter.
5. Citrus trees need little pruning. Only prune branches that are criss crossing each other or an obstruction to your enjoyment.
